

<b>Course 1006 – How to Accurately Interpret the Bible (Elective)</b>	<b>Dr. Floyd D. James</b>
Lead the students to employ the resources and tools of hermeneutics. With these tools, students will engage in biblical analysis during the class period. This is a study of hermeneutics.	
<b>Course 1072 – Survey of the New Testament (COPP Phase 1)</b>	<b>Sister Linda M. Jackson</b>
Engage in a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the New Testament sections of the Bible.	
<b>Course 1075 – The Synoptic Gospels (COPP Phase 2)</b>	<b>Dr. Joseph L. Napier</b>
Focus on the Synoptics Gospels – Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Students will study the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as portrayed by these three writers. Through this comparative study, students will gain a more comprehensive understanding of Jesus’ ministry.	
<b>Course 1112 – Survey of Revelation (COPP Phase 4) (AM Session)</b>	<b>Dr. Lillie MW Shaffer</b>
Explore the book of Revelation, with emphases on authorship, date, theme, and recipients. Discuss the prophetic themes, symbols, and interpretations of various revelations.	
<b>Course 2013 – The Baptist Church Covenant (Elective) (AM Session)</b>	<b>Dr. Dolly Robinson</b>
Explore the design and fundamental study of biblical mandates of our Baptist church covenant.	
<b>Course 2093 – A Christian View towards the Poor, Hungry, and Disadvantaged</b>	<b>Sister Sharon Hartshorn</b>
Teach the importance and the responsibilities of the church from a biblical perspective as they relate to the development of outreach ministries aimed at providing assistance to the underprivileged and disabled in various categories.	
<b>Course 3008 – Theology and History of Christianity (COPP Phase 2)</b>	<b>Dr. Michael Jones</b>
Outline the development of the Christian movement from the beginning of Jesus’ ministry on Earth to present times. Focus on the history, theology, culture, and times that enable Christianity to develop and grow. Prominent persons who influenced the Christian movement will be identified.	
<b>Course 7010 – Introduction to Discipleship (COPP Phase 3) (AM)</b>	<b>Dr. Carolyn C. Walker-Ganison</b>
Introduce the believer to the biblical principle of discipleship. Examine the character traits of believers, while looking at the overall examples of Jesus. Study discipleship methods of Jesus and the difference between discipleship and membership.
