### FACT SHEET

As we focus on our mandate to be "examples of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith and in purity", the Women of Salem District have taken on a Mission Project for 2019 designed to provide support, encouragement and tangible gifts to those who are less fortunate than ourselves. To achieve this mission, we have adopted the New Moms organization and dedicated ourselves to making a difference in the lives of their residents by making monthly contributions of items on their wish list.

**ABOUT NEW MOMS . . .** The New Moms organization exists to interrupt the cycle of poverty and create strong families. ***Their mission*** is to share the love of God by surrounding young moms and their children with everything they need to transform their lives. Every day, they show up for each young mom, ready to support her as she finds a safe place to live, gets a job, and becomes a strong leader for her family – ***because if we don't, the cycle of poverty will continue.***

**HOW SALEM DISTRICT CAN HELP . . .** Each month the Women of Salem District are encouraged to work with members of their local church Missionary Society, Women's Ministry and members of their congregations to collect and donate the "ITEMS OF THE MONTH" to be donated to New Moms. Each Monday and Wednesday during our monthly District Association meetings, collection bins will be available to collect the donations and once they are inventoried, they will be delivered to New Moms on behalf of Salem District. In an effort to take a wholistic approach to this project, each month will be focused on a particular area of need for the New Moms organization.

**THE NEEDS . . .** Working from a wish list provided by New Moms, each month Salem District will focus on being a blessing to the organization and residents through this Mission Project. The monthly focus is outlined below:

**MARCH [Focus: Children]**

- Baby Lotion
- Baby Oil
- Baby Wash
- Baby Shampoo

**APRIL [Focus: Moms]**

- Hair Care Products [full size]: Motions, Luster's Pink, ORS or Dark and Lovely
- Toothpaste, Toothbrushes and Deodorant

**MAY [Focus: Children]**

- Baby Diapers [All sizes – particularly sizes 4-6]
- Baby Formula [Enfamil - Infant (yellow can), Gentlease ( purple can), A.R. ( salmon can)]

**JUNE [Focus: Moms]**

- Sanitary Napkins and Tampons
- Cookbooks
- Socks
- Underware [all sizes]

**JULY [Focus: Residential Facility]**

- Paper Towels
- Toilet Paper
- Dishwashing Liquid
- Hand Soap
- Sponges
- Dish Cloths

As we celebrate our Annual Session, we will invite representatives from New Moms to be present to receive the donation for the residential facility.
